- Forest industry continues to be one of the top industries investing in Alabama's economy the average investment for last 10 years is \$600 million per year and more than 1,000 new jobs per year
 - Forest industry is the engine driving Alabama's rural economy
- In 2018, forest industry was largest capital investor in 15 rural counties in Alabama
 - Forestry contributes \$23 billion annually to Alabama's economy
 - Year after year, forest products ranks in top 5 exports out of port of Mobile
