#### IN THIS REPORT

- Our latest definitive ranking of America's most popular governors, topped by Phil Scott of Vermont for the 8<sup>th</sup> quarter in a row. Wes Moore of Maryland and Jim Justice of West Virginia replace Kristi Noem of South Dakota and Laura Kelly of Kansas in the top 10.
- Our latest definitive ranking of America's most unpopular governors, led by Kim Reynolds of Iowa for the second quarter in a row. Michelle Lujan Grisham of New Mexico is the only new entrant in the top 10, replacing JB Pritzker of Illinois.
- A roundup of 2024's three incumbents, including two who survived primaries last month: Greg Gianforte of Montana and Spencer Cox of Utah.
- A look at how the governors comprising the so-called Democratic bench, who are typically mentioned as possible vice presidential candidates following Kamala Harris' ascendancy to the top of the party's ticket, are performing among key voter groups in their states.
- A trend spotlight on two governors who were particularly busy with their legislatures in the first half of 2024, Jim Pillen of Nebraska and Jeff Landry of Louisiana.



Shares of U.S. voters in each state who approve or disapprove of the job performance of the following U.S. governors:







Shares of registered voters in Montana who approve or disapprove of Gov. Greg Gianforte (R-Mont.)





Shares of registered voters in Utah who approve or disapprove of Gov. Spencer Cox (R-Utah)



Shares of registered voters in Vermont who approve or disapprove of Gov. Phil Scott (R-Vt.)







Shares of registered voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




#### Beshear and Whitmer are the most popular among Democratic voters

Shares of Democratic voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




#### Beshear and Whitmer lead other potential VP options among independent voters

Shares of independent voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




#### Beshear is also the most popular among Republicans

Shares of Republican voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




#### Moore is the most popular among Hispanic voters ...

Shares of Hispanic voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




# ... while Whitmer is the most popular among Black voters

Shares of Black voters in each state who approve of the job performance of each Democratic governor




#### Moore is the most popular among the youngest voters





Charlie Kirk.



Shares of registered voters in Louisiana who approve or disapprove of Gov. Jeff Landry (R-La.)




