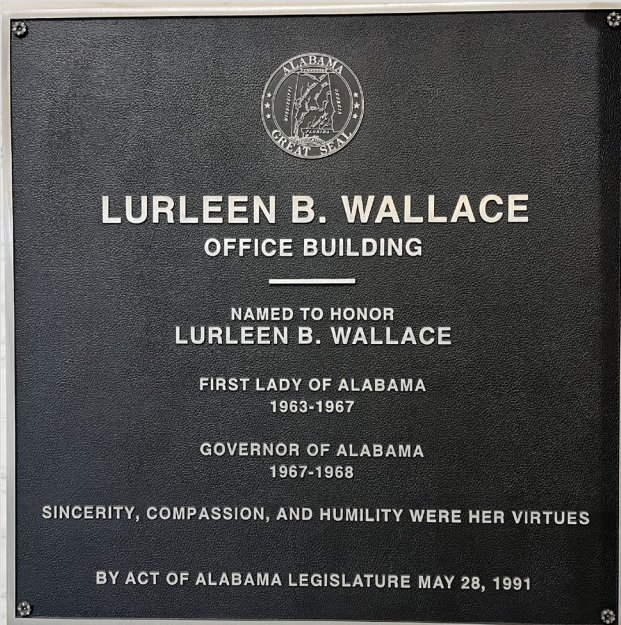
QUICK FACTS

- 115,648 square feet over five floors

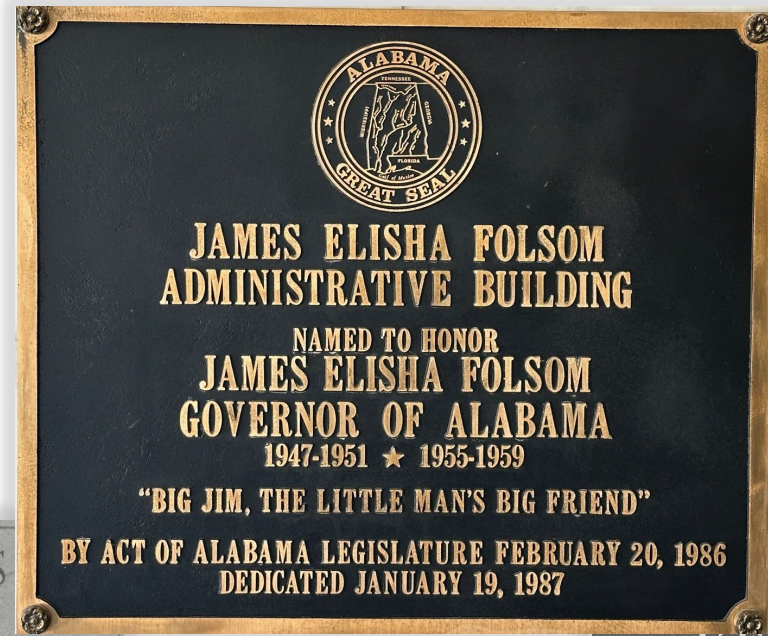

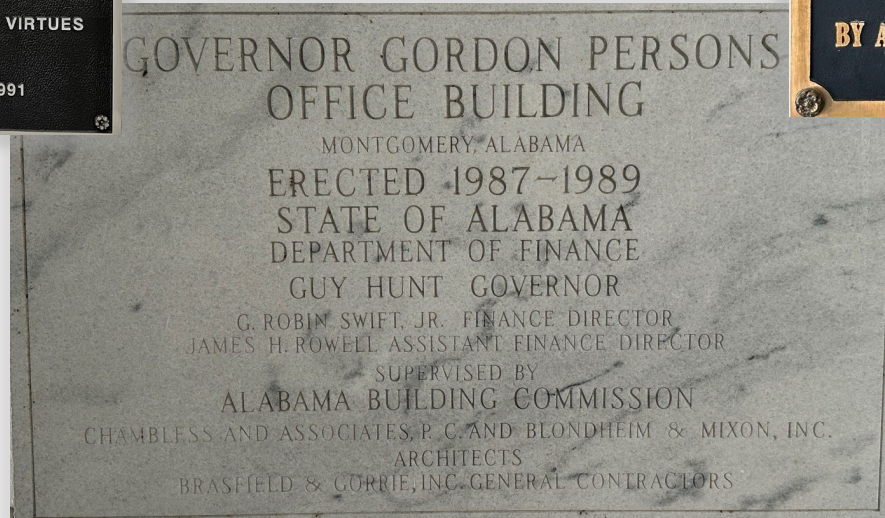

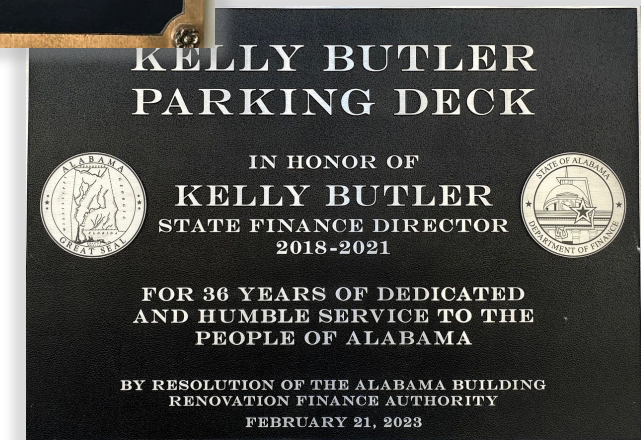
