 RE: Katherine Robertson Leads By Double Digits in Alabama Attorney General Race

A recent statewide survey of likely 2026 Alabama Republican Primary voters (N=400 live calls; MoE +/-5%; May 2-4, 2026) shows Katherine Robertson with a double-digit lead over her next closest opponent.

Robertson leads across the state among all key subgroups. She leads in every media market and among men and women of all ages -- including a 13% lead among voters ages 65+, who will comprise roughly 51% of the overall primary electorate. Robertson leads by double digits among Trump/MAGA party wing voters (who make up 70% of the electorate), among Conservatives (88% of the electorate) and “perfect” 4/4 voters.
